



Terms and conditions  
Qantas Sydney WorldPride Regional Grants

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms and conditions of entry. By submitting an entry into the Qantas Sydney WorldPride Regional Grants program, you agree to the following conditions.
2. The promoters are Mardi Gras Arts Pty Ltd ('SGLMG') ABN 41 158 800 018 of Level 2, 81-83 Oxford St, Darlinghurst NSW 2010 ('Promoters').
3. Applications are open to Australian residents who reside in regional or remote areas and who identify as LGBTQIA+ or a LGBTQIA+ ally (Eligible Applicants).
4. Applications for the Qantas Sydney WorldPride Regional Grants program will not be accepted from government organisations or government officials; employees or contractors for Qantas, Sydney Gay and Lesbian Mardi Gras or Sydney WorldPride; applications who have received funding from an airline other than Qantas to participate in Sydney WorldPride 2023.
5. Applications open 9:00AM AEDT on Tuesday 10 January 2023 and close 11:59PM AEDT on Sunday 29 January 2023 (Application period). To enter the promotion, Eligible Applicants must, within the Application Period, complete and submit the grants application online at <https://www.mardigras.org.au/qantas-sydney-worldpride-regional-grants/> All entries are deemed to be received at the time of receipt by the promoters, not at the time of transmission by the person.
6. There is a limit of one entry per Eligible Applicant.
7. All entrants agree to their entry, in full or in part, being published and attributed to them in the event that they are selected for a Grant.
8. In the instance that a successful applicant is under the age of 18, they must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
9. The Eligible Applicant grants to the Promoters a non-exclusive, perpetual, irrevocable, royalty-free, world-wide license to use their entry, in whole or in part, in accordance with these terms and conditions, in any media (including banners, signage, posters, television, magazine, Internet, Facebook, Instagram, MMS, DVD or other digital or print formats) for an unlimited time for any purpose, including but not limited to publishing the entry on the Promoter's website, promoting future promotions and grants of a similar nature, and whether or not in connection with the Promoter's promotions, advertising or marketing. Where any part of an entry includes personal information, the promoters will obtain the consent of the relevant individual before publishing the entry.
10. Incomplete, indecipherable, or illegible entries will be deemed invalid and will be rejected. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entry where it reasonably suspects that such materials are prohibited by these terms and conditions, any relevant law, or are otherwise deemed inappropriate. This is at the Promoter's absolute discretion and discussions will not be entered into.
11. The Promoters reserve the right to verify the validity of entries and Eligible Applicants and reserves the right to disqualify any Eligible Applicant for tampering with the entry process or



for submitting an entry that is not (in the reasonable opinion of the Promoters) in accordance with these terms and conditions.

12. The Promoters are not responsible for any lost, late or misdirected entries including delays due to technical disruptions, network congestion or any other reason.

## **JUDGING**

1. The Promoter will appoint a panel of judges for each Promotion Period. Judges will examine all entries and select, in their absolute discretion, the entry that they judge to be the best in accordance with the criteria set out in Clause 12.
2. The criteria on which entries will be judged are:
  - a. The ability of the applicant to demonstrate a meaningful connection to a LGBTQIA+ community within regional or remote Australia
  - b. The extent to which the applicant can identify tangible efforts to foster LGBTQIA+ inclusion within their community
  - c. The extent to which an applicant can detail the positive benefits that a grant would provide to the Individual
3. The judging will take place at a nominated location in Australia no later than the 31 January 2023.
4. Successful applicants will be notified on 1 February 2023.
5. Successful applicants will be contacted via email and phone using the contact details provided in the Eligible Applicant's grant application. In the event that the Promoters are unable to contact a successful applicant after three attempts, no less than 24 hours apart, that applicant will forfeit the grant and a replacement Eligible Applicant will be awarded the grant in their place. The replacement applicant will be contacted by phone by 5:00pm AEDT on the same day.
6. The Promoters reserve the right to rejudge in the event of an applicant being unable to satisfy these terms and conditions, forfeiting or not claiming a grant. For any element of the grant that remains unclaimed or forfeited through ineligibility or otherwise by 3:00pm AEDT on 17 February 2023, the winner will forfeit that portion of the grant and no compensation will be paid in lieu and that grant may not be awarded.
7. The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Attempts to contact the judging panel directly may result in the disqualification of the Eligible Applicant.
8. The Promoters reserve the right in their sole discretion to disqualify any Eligible Applicant which the Promoters have reason to believe has breached any of these conditions or in the opinion of the Promoters, has engaged in conduct in entering the promotion, which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the promotion and/or the Promoters and/or the Official Sponsors.
9. A total of 8 grants will be available and will be offered to one successful applicant from each Australian State and territory.
10. No grant in whole or in part will be exchangeable for cash.
11. Each grant must be taken as stated and no compensation will be payable if the Winning Applicant is unable to use the grant as stated. A grant cannot be transferred to any other person, unless agreed to by the Promoters.

13. The Promoters are not liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or a consequential loss), or for personal injury suffered or sustained as a result of taking any grant, except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law.
14. The Promoters will not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever resulting from incorrect details being lodged by applicants.
15. The Promoters reserve the right to vary the rules of the promotion, or any grants offered or cancel the competition if they are no longer able to run the promotion due to reasons beyond their control, subject to law. The Promoters will not be liable for any losses to any Event arising from any variation or cancellation. This agreement will be governed and construed according to the laws of NSW, Australia, without regard to any conflict of law provisions. Any suit or proceeding arising out of these terms and conditions, between the Promoters and any third Event (other than the Official Sponsors) will be resolved in the federal or state courts as applicable in NSW, Australia and each Event submits to the jurisdiction and venue of such courts.

The Promoters are not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information or for any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilised in this competition, or for any technical error, or any combination thereof that may occur in the course of the administration of this competition including any omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line or telephone, mobile or satellite network failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to or alteration of entries.
17. Each Eligible Applicant's personal information is collected for the purposes of conducting this promotion. Any disclosure of such information will be made as required by law and in accordance with these terms and conditions. The Promoters may disclose your information to the Official Sponsors and to third parties who are assisting the Promoters, their service and content providers (including those located outside Australia) and to the Promoters' related companies, including those located outside of Australia.

## **GRANTS**
